It takes much more of the grace of God, and much greater awareness

Colossians 3:23-24 "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men, since you know that you will receive an

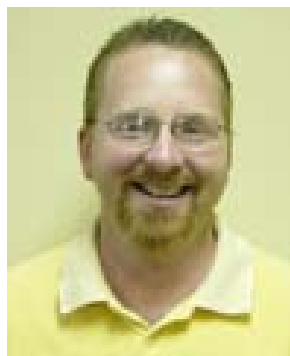
# Word of the Month
